WELCOME

Welcome to Clonmell House, 17 Harcourt Street. Steeped in history, Dublin's original Mansion House, Clonmell House dates back to 1778 and boasts a wealth of original ornate features including a magnificent sweeping staircase and some of the most decorative plasterwork and cornicing of its time.

HISTORY

One of Dublin's most prestigious Georgian streets, Harcourt Street was first opened by John Hatch in 1777. The following year, Hatch completed a large house near the middle of the west side of the street, now No. 17. This was sold to Attorney General John Scott, later Lord Clonmell, and the original 'Copper Faced Jack', in 1778.

The original design was a large brick mansion of 120 feet frontage; however the wings were later replaced by houses, reducing the frontage of Clonmell house to approximately 60 feet. Since 1830 the mansion has been divided into two houses. The larger section, No 17, housed Sir Hugh Lane's Municipal Gallery of Modern Art until Charlemount House was later used for that purpose. In 2007, the Institute of Certified Public Accountants in Ireland (CPA) purchased 17 Harcourt Street as its headquarters.

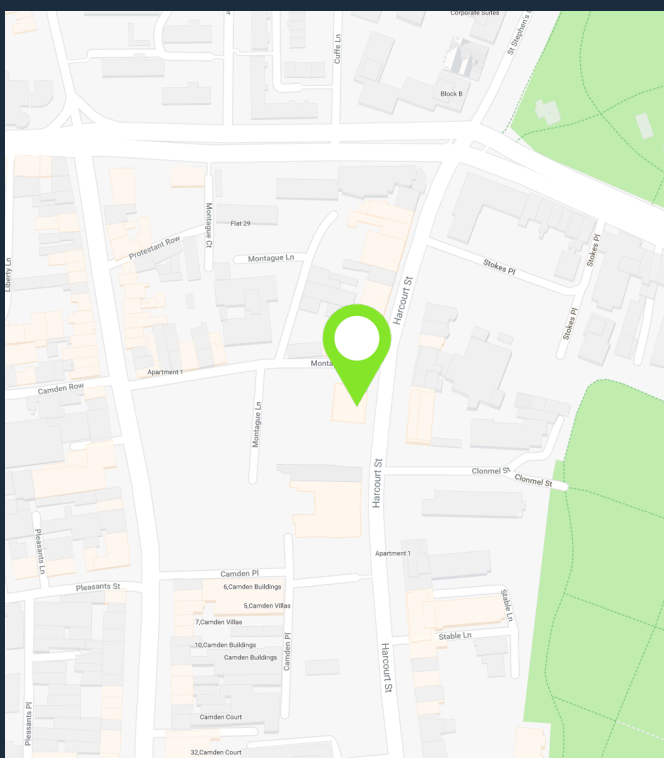
