Applications are invited for external members to the Audit & Risk and Finance Committees of LMETB.

Three to five external members are required for the Audit & Risk committee and at least one for the Finance committee.

LMETB is a statutory authority with responsibility for education and training, youth work and a range of other statutory functions in Louth and Meath. LMETB manages and operates second-level schools, further education colleges, community national schools and a range of adult and further education and training centres throughout Louth and Meath including the Regional Skills and Training Centre in Dundalk. LMETB's 2018 expenditure was €125 million.
